As high tech as many toys now are, you can't beat arts and crafts and activity toys for hours of simple, basic fun:

**EASY-BAKE CLASSIC OVEN FROM HASBRO. AGES 8 AND UP. \$24.99.**

More than 40 years old, the Easy-Bake Oven is still going strong. Now the oven is getting a makeover of sorts, with the light bulb being replaced with a more realistic cooking unit. The result? Better baking — and better tasting mixes.

**DOODLE DOUG FROM OHIO ART. AGES 3 AND UP. \$14.99.** Sometimes kids need a little help when creating their masterpieces. That's where Doodle Doug comes in. Slip the felt-tip markers in his adjustable arms and Doug will just doodle away.

**MOON SAND FROM SPIN MASTER. AGES 3 AND UP. \$19.99.** Weather sometimes prevents you from making great sand castles. No more. While Spin Master's Moon Sand looks just like regular sand, it can be shaped like dough — and never dries out.

**CRAYOLA COLOR EXPLOSION SPINNER FROM BINNEY & SMITH. AGES 6 AND UP. \$24.99.** The updated spin-art machine allows young artists to create eye-popping artwork by using special markers and clear-color reveal solution onto black paper.

**CRAYOLA TELESCOPING CRAYON TOWER FROM BINNEY & SMITH. AGES 5 AND UP. \$14.99.** Crayola crayons are great for creating works of art, but they're not always easy to keep together. No more. The new three-tier tower holds 150 crayons, and when it's time to clean up, the tower shrinks down for easy storage.
