**GLUD & MARSTRAND TO OPEN FIRST DOMESTIC
PRODUCTION SITE AT OHIO ART FACILITIES –
MOVE TO CREATE SEVERAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

*Leading metal packaging manufacturer to become major new
lithography customer for Bryan toy company*

BRYAN, OH, May 11, 2007 – Glud & Marstrand, Scandinavia’s largest producer of metal packaging, and The Ohio Art Company announced today that they have entered into an operating agreement that will enable Glud and Marstrand to open its first U.S. operation at the toy company’s home in Bryan, Ohio. As part of the agreement, Glud & Marstrand will lease manufacturing space at Ohio Art’s facility and also become a major new lithography customer for the company. The collaboration is expected to create over 40 new employment opportunities in the Bryan area over the next three years.

After a well considered search for an appropriate site in the U.S. for its production facilities, Glud & Marstrand chose Ohio Art’s facility as an ideal site and manufacturing vendor. “We believe that with Ohio Art, we have found a partner that is a strong fit for our business and will help us to develop and grow our business in order to meet our long term strategic objectives,” said Stig Rasmussen, General Manager for Glud & Marstrand.

G & M Media produces the Steelbook™ package for high-end DVDs and video games sold as boxed sets and special editions for major studios and game producers. As they continue to further develop the market for Steelbook, G&M will invest in new machinery and equipment for the facility that will be used to establish their Bryan-based headquarters and operations.

“G&M is a significant new lithography customer for Ohio Art and we are thrilled that they have selected our space as the best location for their first U.S. headquarters,” stated John Gostkowski, Vice President of Lithographic Operations for Ohio Art. “We are really looking forward to working together with them as a team,” he added.

Although Glud & Marstrand will lease space within the Ohio Art facility, both will remain independent. G&M expects to move its machinery to Bryan by June and to begin production by mid-July, 2007.
